

Guidelines for Poster presentations

- The entire poster must be no more than A0 in size (1189 mm long x 841 mm high). It should be laminated so that it can be attached to a vertical poster board. Posters should not be three-dimensional.
- The poster should be oriented in the "landscape" position (long dimension is horizontal).
- A banner displaying your poster title, name, institution and email address should be positioned at top-centre of the poster.
- Please make it obvious to the viewer how to progressively view the poster. The poster generally should read from left to right, and top to bottom. Numbering the individuals panels, or connecting them with arrows may assist readers.
